The Royal Historical Society offers annually the Whitfield Prize (value £1,000) for a new book on British or Irish history. To be eligible for consideration the book must be on a subject within a field of British or Irish history and have been published in English in 2015. It must also be its author's first solely written book and be an original and scholarly work of historical research.
